COLLECTION GUIDE Equipment

White container with brown screw top.

Specimen Collection

- 1. Label the container with the patient's full name, date of birth, UR number (if applicable), time and date of collection.
- 2. It is suggested that your faeces sample is collected initially into a plastic disposable container (an ice-cream container is ideal).
- 3. Place a small portion (about the size of a walnut) in the container.
- 4. Ensure lid is tightly sealed. Place in specimen bag and seal.
- 5. Refrigerate specimens and send to the laboratory on the day of collection.
