PATIENT INSTRUCTIONS – GLUCOSE TOLERANCE TEST



If you have any English language difficulties, please ask staff to book an interpreter. From home contact the Telephone Interpreter Service on 9605 3056. Services are provided free of charge. Ask staff if this information is available in your preferred language.

Background Information

This test measures the body's ability to handle a glucose load.

Patient Instructions

- For three days prior to the test you should consume your normal diet. There is no need to avoid any particular foods in this time. Drink plenty of water.
- The test should not be performed if you are unwell with an infection, have had recent surgery or trauma. Please advise the staff if you are on any special medications.
- You are required to fast overnight up to a maximum of 16 hours. This means you should have nothing to eat from 11.00pm the night before the test. This includes chewing gum, lollies, tea and coffee. You are advised to drink water.
- No physical activity or smoking is permitted during the test and a 30 minute rest period is required prior to the commencement of the test. You will not be able to walk around during the test. (Note: the test will take 2-3 hours keep in mind that you are not permitted to leave to fill a 2-hour parking meter.)
- The test is performed between 08.00 and 10.00 Monday to Friday. Please call the appropriate phone number (see below) to make the necessary appointment.
- At the commencement of the test a blood sample is taken and the fasting glucose checked.
- A chilled drink containing a known amount of glucose will be given to you. You must drink the entire bottle within five
 minutes. Please inform the staff if you are unable to drink the entire amount or if you have vomited any portion of this
 drink.
- Two more blood samples are collected at 1 and 2 hour intervals after the drink is ingested.
