

ADULT NASAL SWAB COLLECTION GUIDE

Equipment

- PCR/Influenza/H1N1 Nasopharyngeal swab or aspirate required -UTM Viral Transport Medium
- MICROSCOPY & CULTURE General Microscopy & Culture Kit
- Goggles and N95 particulate Mask
- Gloves

Specimen Collection Procedure

- 1. Explain procedure and obtain consent from patient.
- 2. Patient should be lying down or head tilted back resting against wall as they have a tendency to pull head back during this procedure.
- 3. Wash hands or use handrub. Apply gloves.
- 4. If nasal passage is dry, and for comfort of patient as this also works as a lubricant, moisten the swab stick a little with the normal saline.
- 5. Stand to one side of tilted head and back slightly.
- 6. Using a pencil grip insert the swab tip into the nostril as far as the anterior end of the nasal turbinate, parallel to the palate (Approximately 2 3 cm in adults)
- 7. Leave the swab in place for a few seconds then slowly withdraw using a rotating motion.
- 8. Put the swab directly into transport tube.
- 9. Label the tube with patient's details, time, date and source of specimen.
- 10. Wash Hands or use handrub
- 11. Place specimen and request form in specimen transport bag and send to the laboratory

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
