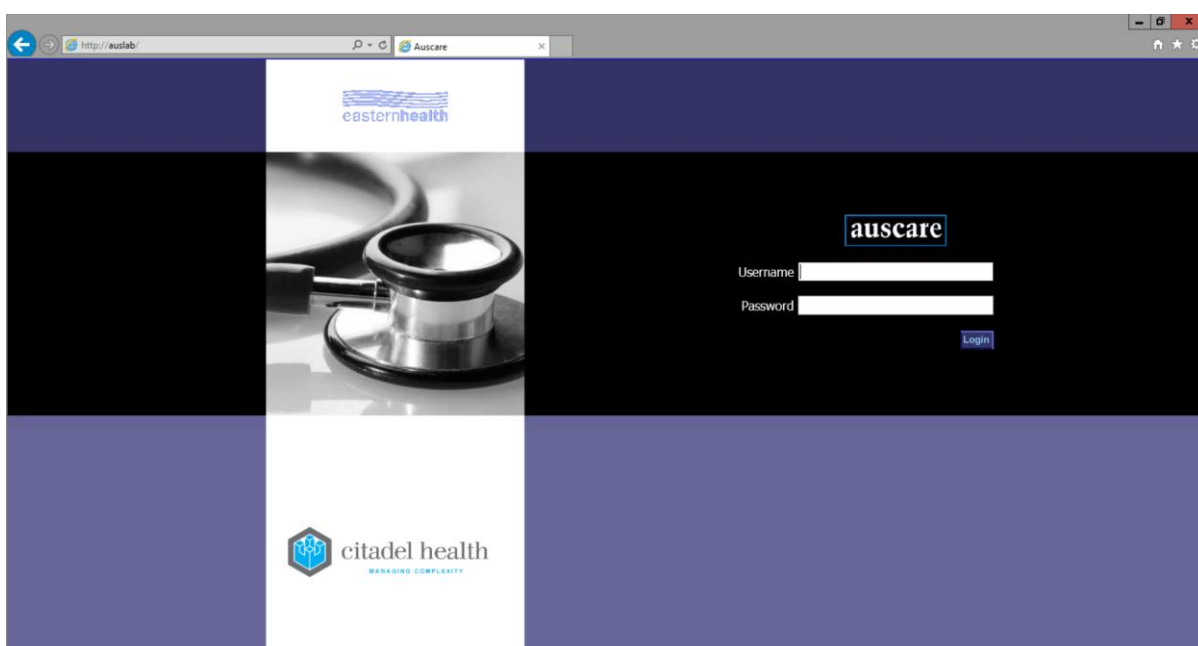


ACCESSING PATHOLOGY RESULTS ON RESULT BROWSER – AUSCARE

1. Pathology will issue you with a User Name and User specific Password. Login is specific to each individual user and must be obtained from Pathology prior to accessing results. Auscare access form can be found [here](#) or on the Pathology Handbook page
2. Under Application on the Eastern Health home, click on Pathology Reports tab.
3. This takes you to the AUSCARE home page



4. On first access, go to the user settings button and change your password (it needs to be 6-8 characters, alphanumeric, lower case e.g. mydog1).
5. AUSCARE allows you to search by many factors.

UR Number

- Enter UR # in patient ID Number field
- Press the 'Search' button in the ID field (or the enter key)
- Press 'Clear' to start over
- Click on the tick box for the patient, then press the 'Submit' button to view details or

Demographics

Type in some or all of the following details:

- Surname and Given Name
- Date of Birth
- Click on Gender radio button
- Then press 'Search' or 'Enter'

Location Attributes

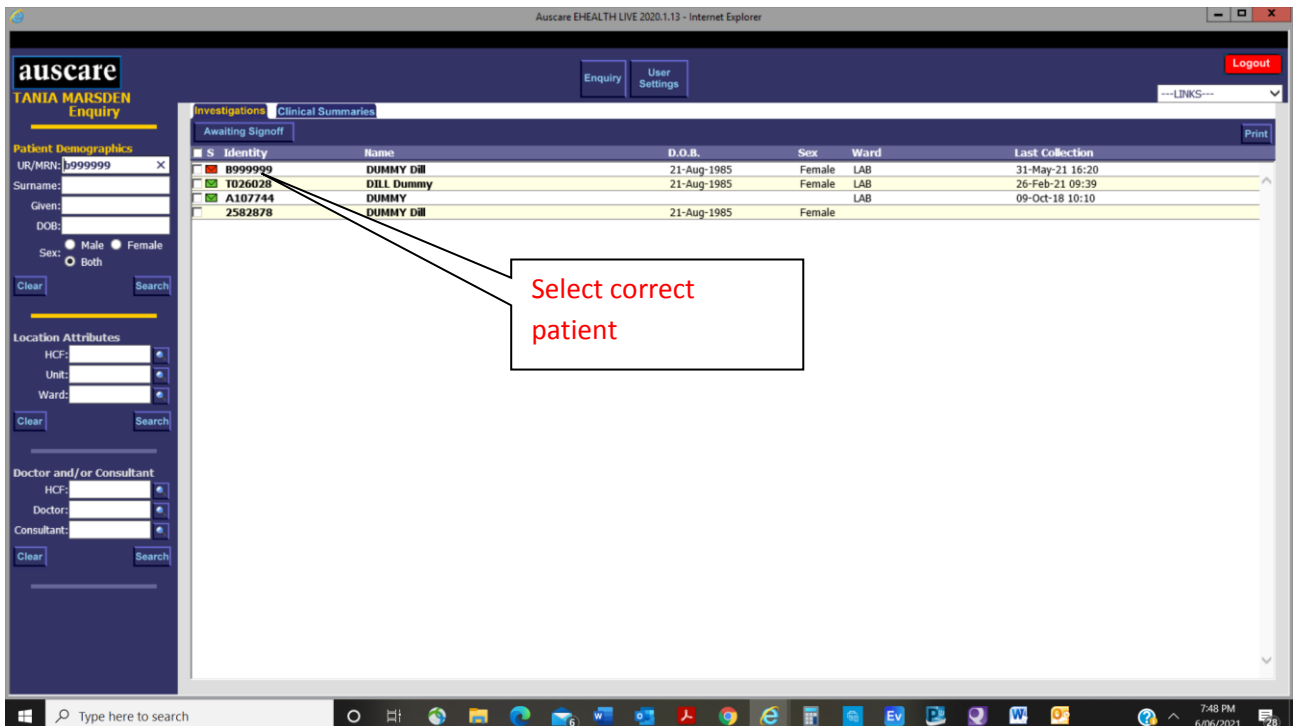
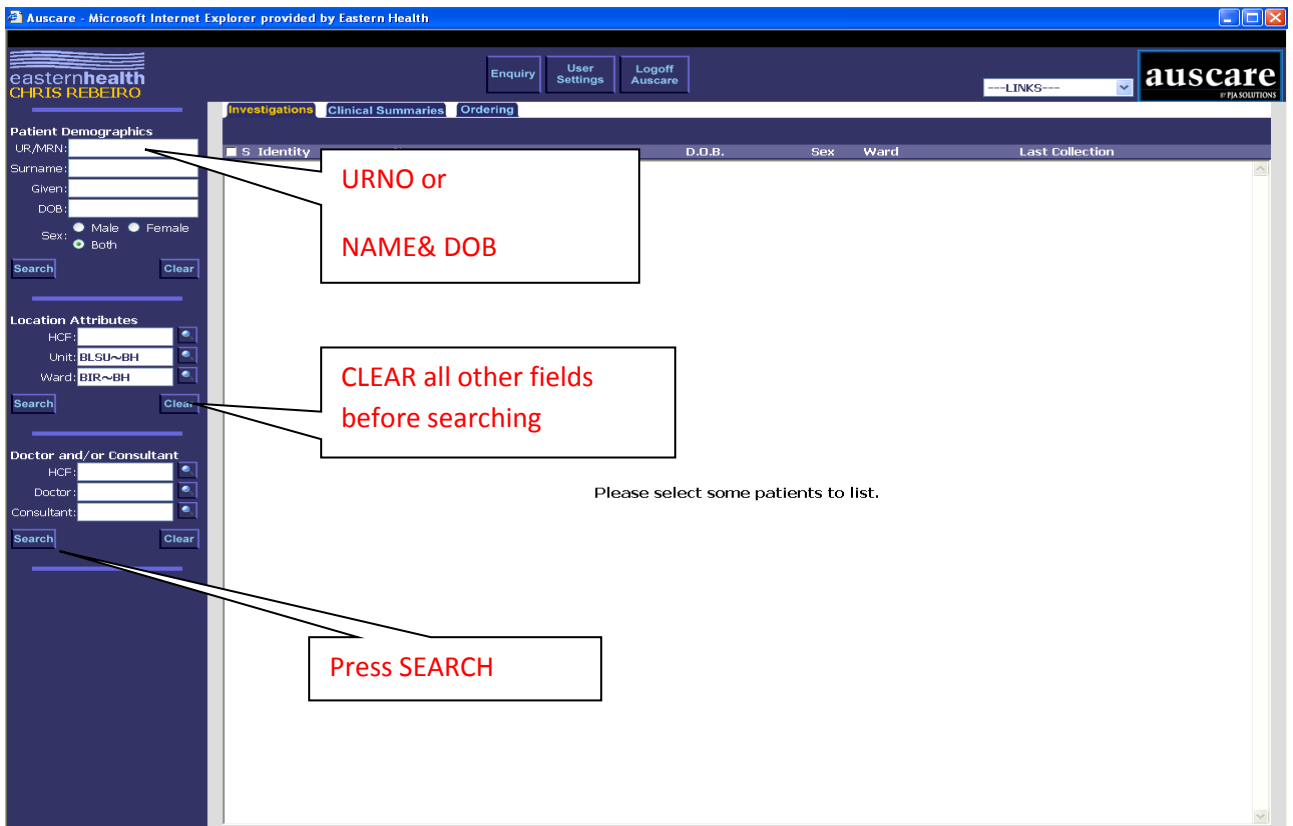
You can generate a patient list to review a clinical unit or ward list rather than individually searching for each patient under the following criteria:

- HCF (Hospital)
- Unit (admitted under)
- Ward
- Doctor

Remember to click on SEARCH to initiate patient search

The list will display with envelope icons.

- **Red envelope** = critical result
 - **Yellow envelope** = borderline result +/- or micro / histo reports
 - **Green envelope** = normal results
- No envelope = all validated results have been reviewed



6. Once correct patient is selected then next screen displays patient details (top of screen) and list of all results down left side of screen
 - a. Select appropriate test required AND
 - b. Check request date and time, double click to view results

7. Repeat search (step 5 above)
8. Click 'LOG OFF' when you have finished accessing pathology results.
9. POINTS to REMEMBER:
 - a. Obtain Specific user LOGIN from Pathology
 - b. Search patient using UR Number, NAME & DOB
 - c. Features of Auscare
 - i. To change password click on USER SETTINGS (top of page)
 - ii. Can set up SEARCH defaults (your hospital site and specific ward)
 - d. ALL User functions and result viewing are AUDITABLE and can be used to retrospectively review accessibility and the appropriate use of the AUSCARE result browser
